## Purpose of handout

The purpose of this handout is to provide I-41 construction information. This handout provides upcoming construction scope, schedule, traffic impacts, business resources, and project contacts.

## Project purpose and need

We are improving seven flyover bridge structures on I-41 at system interchanges in Brown and Winnebago County.

The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the system interchange flyover ramp bridge structures. The existing deck surface is deteriorating and wearing at an accelerated rate.

## Anticipated benefits

Benefits include:

- Increase service life of the flyover structures
- Decrease future maintenance costs
- Provide smoother driving lanes for motorists
- Enhanced safety with a restored bridge deck overlay

## Project location

The project will take place on various flyover ramps on I-41 from US 45 in the city of Oshkosh, Winnebago County, to I-43 in the village of Howard, Brown County.



## Project improvements

This is a bridge preservation project. Project improvements include:

- Milling the deck, performing deck repairs as needed and overlaying with a polyester polymer concrete (PPC) overlay.
- Six interchange flyover ramp bridge overlays are in Brown County.

- Flyover ramp bridge polymer overlay in Winnebago County at the I-41 and US-45 system interchange.

## Schedule and construction staging

### ***Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 and I-43 System Interchange (Planned 2026)***

- Flyover RAMP I-41 northbound TO I-43 southbound over VELP AVE./US 141 (B-5-671)
  - Traffic: Single Lane Closure
- Flyover RAMP I-43 northbound TO I-41 southbound OVER I-41 (B-5-678)
  - Traffic: Single Lane Closure
- Flyover RAMP I-43 northbound TO US 41 OVERLAND ROAD/MAINTENANCE ROAD (B-5-679)
  - Traffic: Single Lane Closure

### ***Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 and WIS 29/WIS 32 System Interchange (Planned 2026 or 2027)***

- Flyover RAMP I-41 southbound TO WIS 29 westbound OVER WIS 29 (B-5-661)
  - Traffic: Closure/detour
  - Detour uses I-41 southbound exit 168 C to WIS 29 westbound
- Flyover RAMP WIS 29 eastbound TO I-41 northbound OVER I-41 (B-5-658)
  - Traffic: Closure/detour
  - Detour uses WIS 29 eastbound exit WIS 29 east/Packerland Drive/Shawano Avenue eastbound to WIS 29 east to I-41 northbound
- Flyover RAMP I-41 northbound TO WIS 29 westbound OVER I-41/WIS 29 (B-5-660)
  - Traffic: Single Lane Closure
  - Mason St. northbound on-ramp to I-41 will be detoured
    - Detour uses I-41 southbound on-ramp at Mason Street to exit 167 I-41/Lombardi Avenue interchange to I-41 northbound

### ***Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 and US 45 System Interchange (Planned 2027)***

- Flyover RAMP I-41 northbound TO US 45 northbound OVER US 45 and I-41 (B-70-269)
  - Traffic: Closure/detour
  - Detour uses US 45/Algoma Blvd exit to US 45 northbound

## Traffic impacts

Long-term single lane closures on the dual lane flyover ramps at system interchanges

- Closure and detour of single lane flyover ramps at system interchanges
- WIS 54/Mason Street ramp to I-41 northbound will be closed and detoured during the I-41 northbound/WIS 32 northbound to WIS 29 westbound/WIS 32 northbound over I-41/WIS 29 flyover ramp
