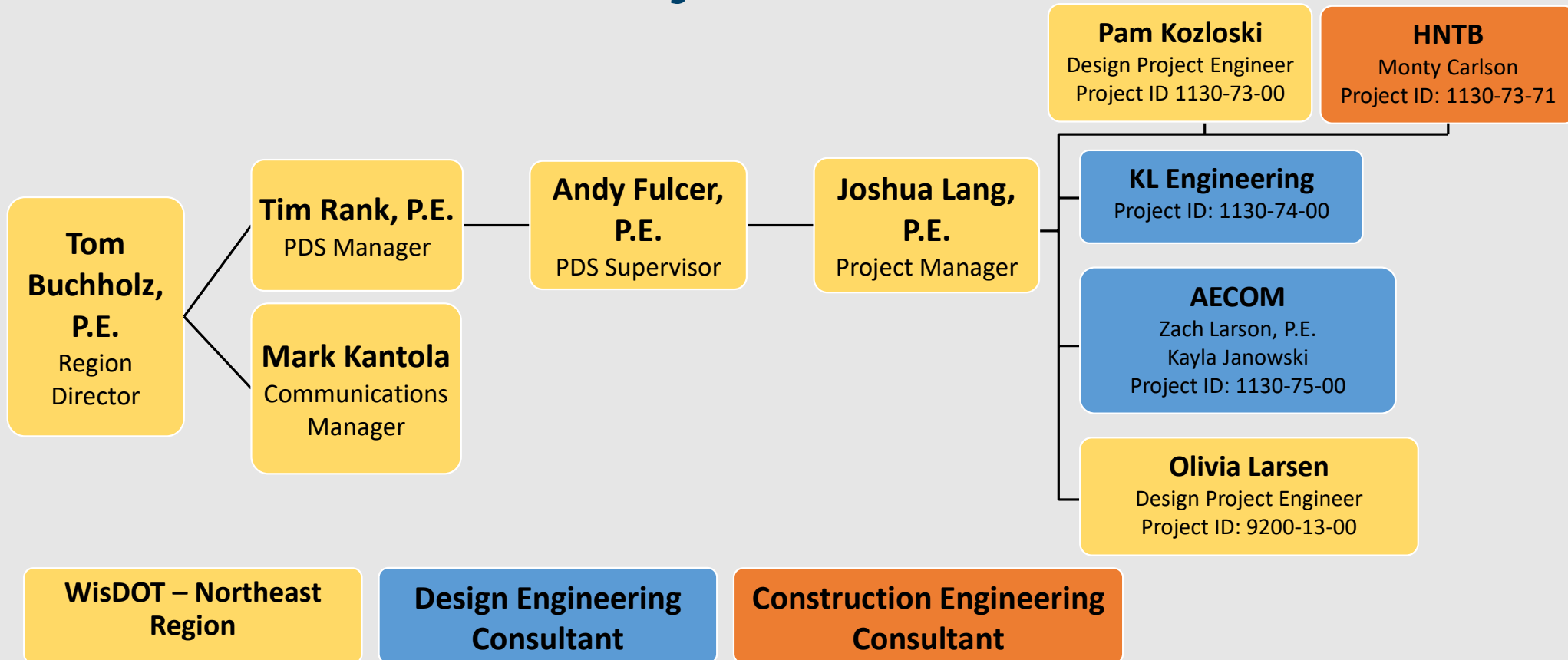

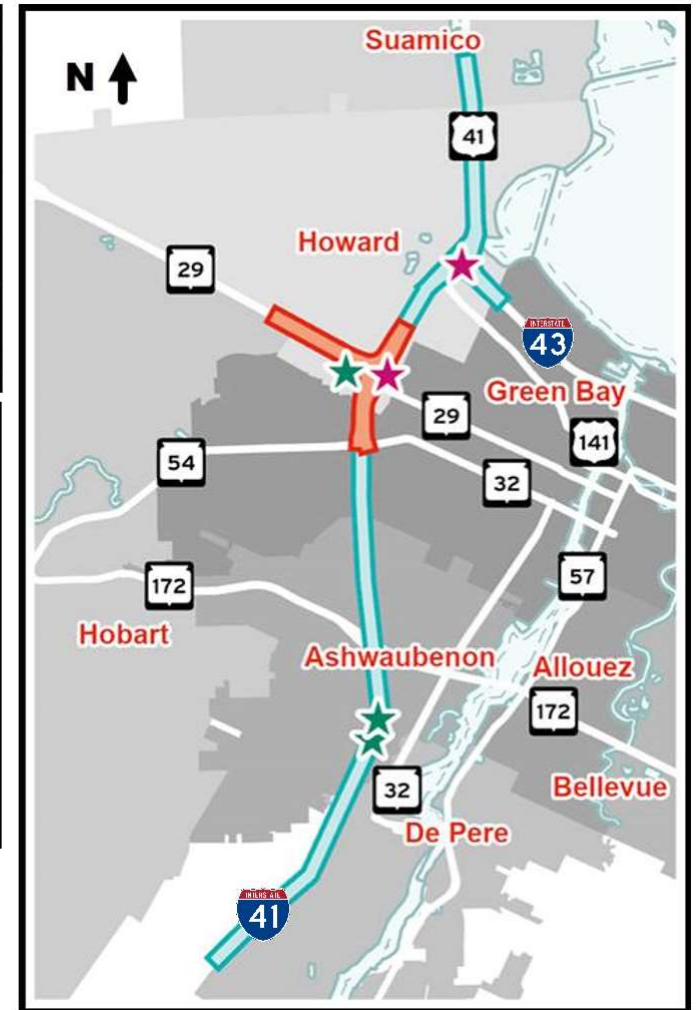
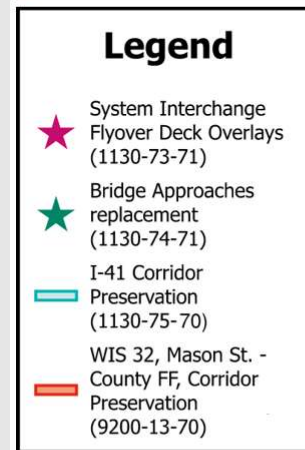

Overall Project Purpose, Need, and Benefits

- Preserve and extend the life of the roadway and structures
- Restore and preserve ride quality
- Reduce future maintenance costs and amount of maintenance activities
- Address settlement since expansion
- Preserve and restore drainage and safety features
- Restore and upgrade pedestrian facilities/curb ramps to meet current standards

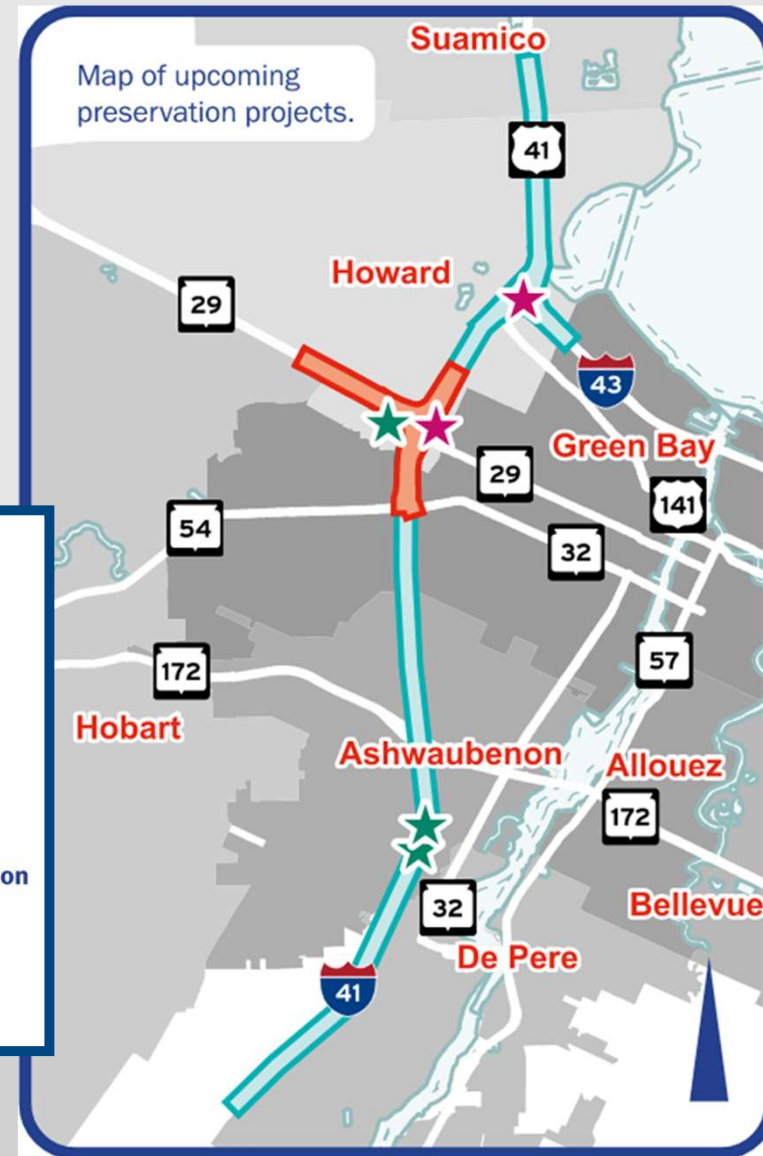

Proposed Improvements



Project and Traffic Impacts

- **Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 & I-43 System Interchange (Planned 2026)**
- I-41 northbound to I-43 southbound flyover ramp
 - Traffic impacts: Single Lane Closure
- I-43 northbound to I-41 southbound flyover ramp
 - Traffic impacts: Single Lane Closure
- I-43 northbound I-41/US 41 northbound flyover ramp
 - Traffic impacts: Single Lane Closure
- Ramp lane closure durations will vary up to several weeks.
- Weather dependent.
- Ideal conditions required.



Project and Traffic Impacts Continued

- **Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 & WIS 29/WIS 32 System Interchange (Planned 2026 or 2027)**
 - I-41 southbound to WIS 29 westbound
 - Traffic impact: full closure of the ramp
 - The detour will use I-41 southbound exit 168 C to WIS 29 westbound
 - WIS 29 eastbound to I-41 northbound
 - Traffic impact: full closure of the ramp
 - The detour will use WIS 29 eastbound to I-41 northbound
 - I-41 northbound to WIS 29 westbound
 - Traffic impact: Single Lane Closure
 - Mason St. NB On-Ramp Detour



Project and Traffic Impacts Continued

- Ramp Closures and Detours at I-41 & WIS 29/WIS 32 System Interchange (Planned 2026 or 2027) Continued

- WIS 29 eastbound to I-41 northbound
 - Traffic: Closure/detour



- I-41 northbound to WIS 29 westbound
 - Traffic: Single Lane Closure
 - Mason St. NB On-Ramp Detour

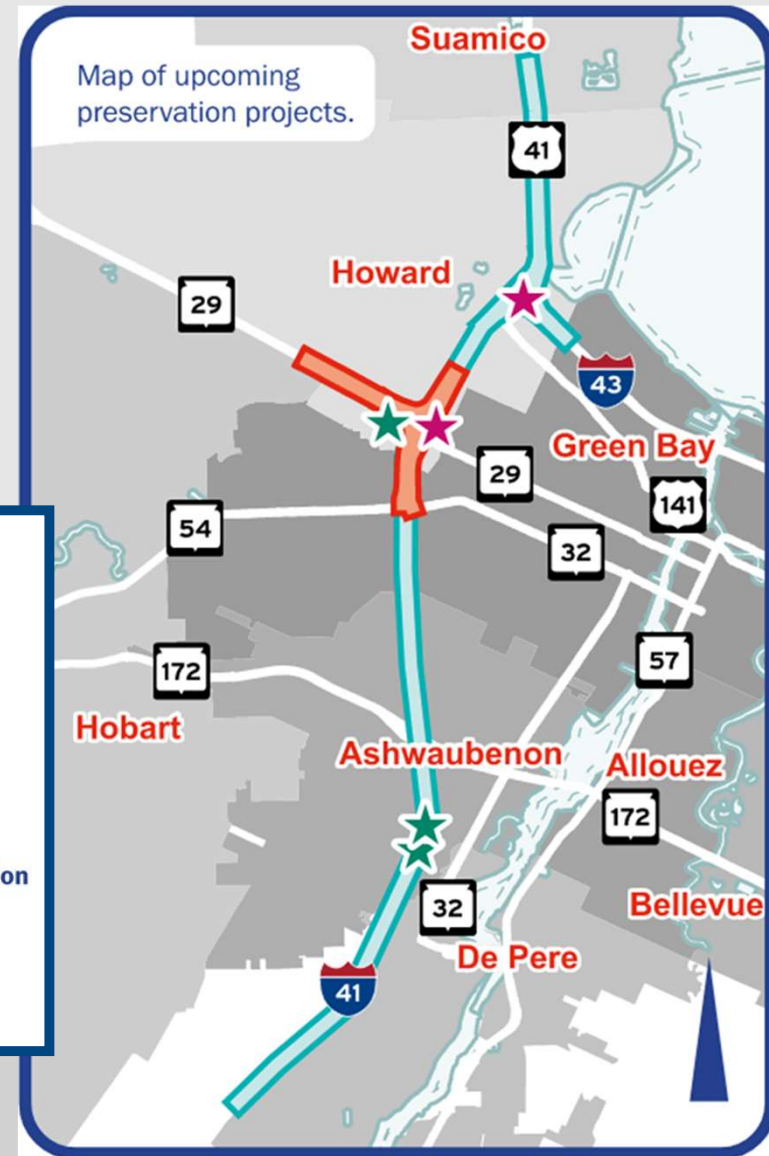

Proposed Improvements

Remove the existing asphalt approach and replace it with concrete before and after the bridges.

Additional pavement work beyond the approach slabs to be included to ensure a smooth profile.

- Approximately 600 feet of pavement will be replaced at the end of each bridge structure



Project and Traffic Impacts

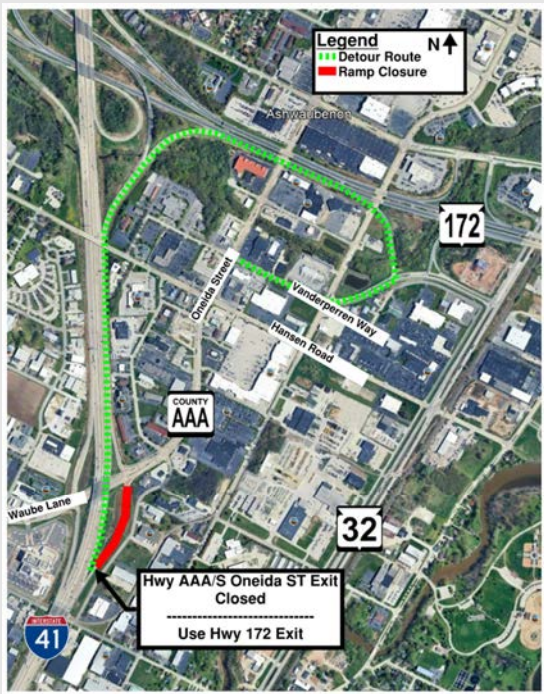
- Traffic Impacts

- I-41 will remain open with lane closures and long-term traffic switches.
- I-41 will be reduced to two lanes in both directions between the Glory Road and Hansen Road overpasses.
- The WIS 29 eastbound to I-41/WIS 32 southbound ramp will be reduced to one lane.
- Ramp closures will occur at Oneida Steet Interchange and Main St. Interchange.

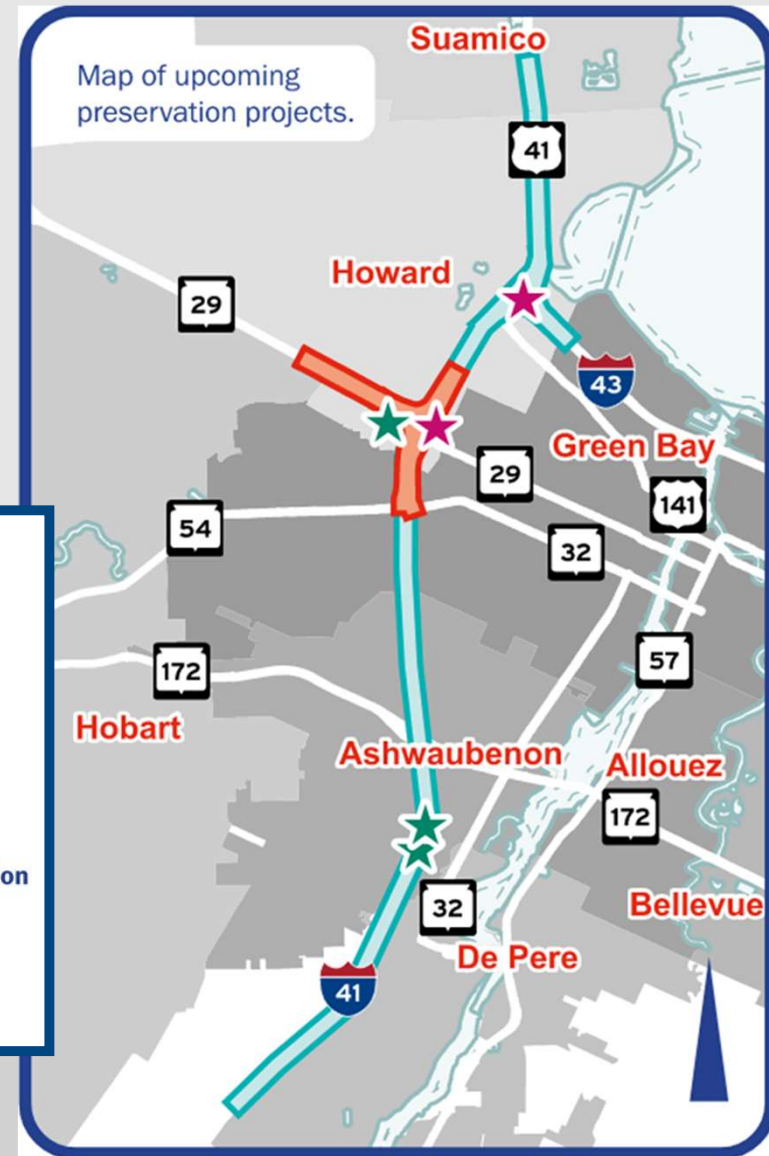

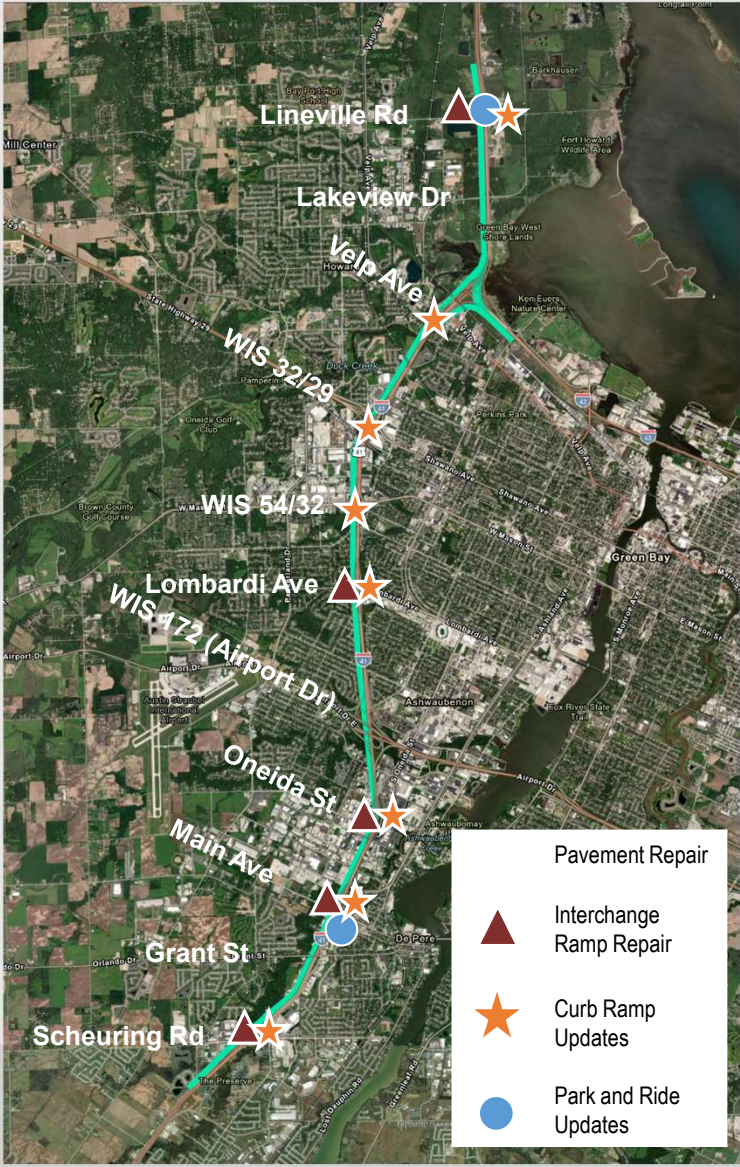

Proposed Improvements

Roadway

- Pavement repair (concrete patching)
 - Main lanes and ramps
- Beam guard replacement
- Culvert replacement/repair
- Storm sewer inlet repair
- Curb ramp reconstruction / upgrades
- Pavement Marking re-striping
- Park and Ride re-striping



Proposed Improvements

Structures

- 84 secondary structure repairs including:
 - Joint Sealing
 - Spot painting
 - Concrete surface repair
 - Other minor miscellaneous maintenance



Project and Traffic Impacts

- Traffic Impacts

- Temporary Lane Closures

- Traffic will remain both NB and SB
 - Nighttime / off-peak lane and shoulder closures will occur

- Temporary Ramp Closures

- Nighttime / off-peak closures of ramps will occur
 - Pedestrian and multimodal accommodations

- Other Project Impacts:

- No real estate anticipated
 - Minor wetland impacts



Project Schedules/Next Steps

- Project Initiation – begin data collection and preliminary design: 2024
- Public Involvement: January/February 2026
- Final Environmental Document Approval: Spring 2026
- Preliminary Design Complete: May 2026
- Right of Way Acquisition: Not Anticipated
- Utility Relocations: Fall 2027
- Final Plans: May 2028
- Construction is currently scheduled to begin in 2029

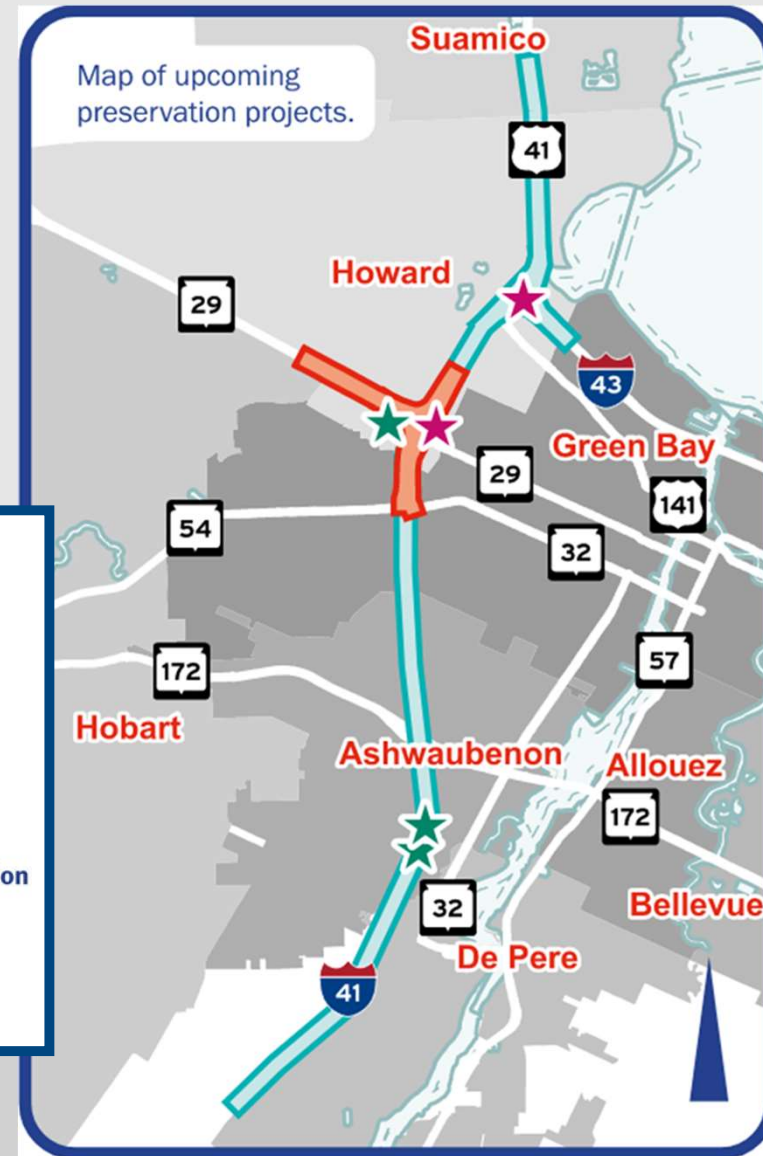

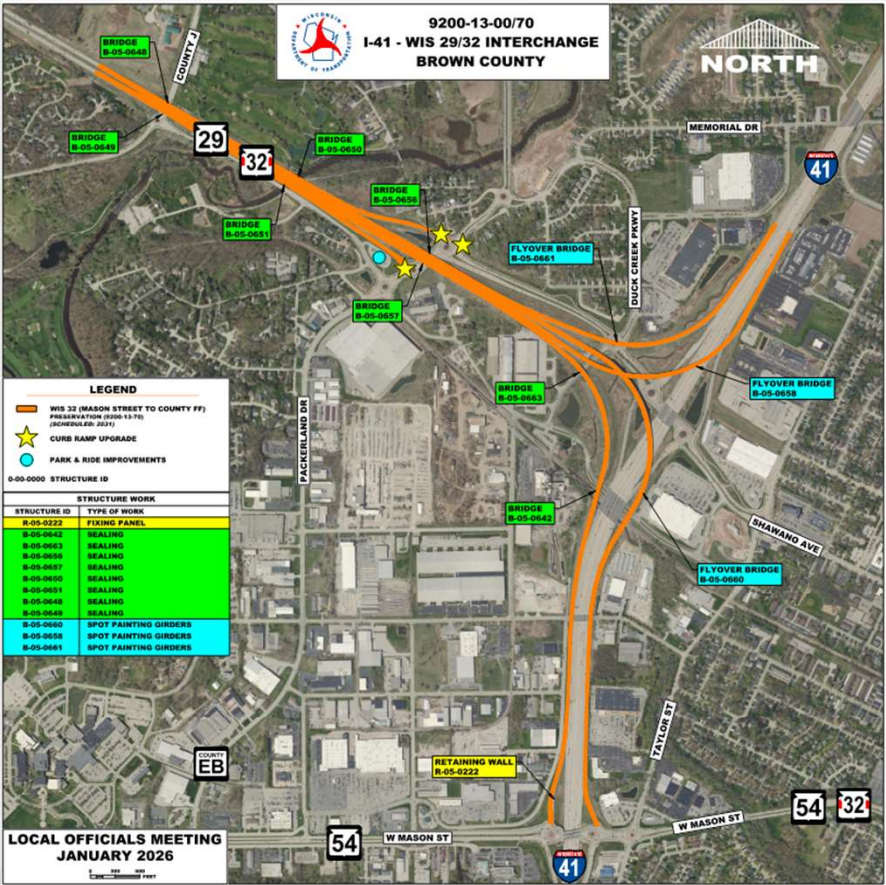

Proposed Improvements

- Pavement repair (concrete patching)
 - Main lanes and ramps
- Beam guard replacement
- Culvert and storm sewer replacement/repairs
- Curb ramp reconstruction / upgrades
- Pavement Marking re-striping
- Park and Ride improvements
- Structure Repairs at approximately 12 locations

- Nighttime / off-peak closures of ramps will occur

- Public Involvement: **January/February 2026**
- Final Environmental Document Approval: **Summer 2027**
- Preliminary Design Complete: **Spring 2028**
- Right of Way Acquisition: **Not Anticipated**
- Utility Relocations: **Fall 2029**
- Final Plans: **Spring 2030**
- Construction is currently scheduled to begin in **2031**

Temporary Business Signage Process

- Prior to Construction

- Coordinate with neighboring businesses to discuss needs and identify a signage plan
- Submit a business sign permit application that includes proposed sign design and locations
- Once approved, purchase signs and be ready for construction

- During Construction

- Businesses install and maintain temporary business signage throughout construction
- Stay connected with the project team to receive updates via email

- End of Construction

- Businesses remove all signs once construction is complete
- Let customers know that access is back to normal

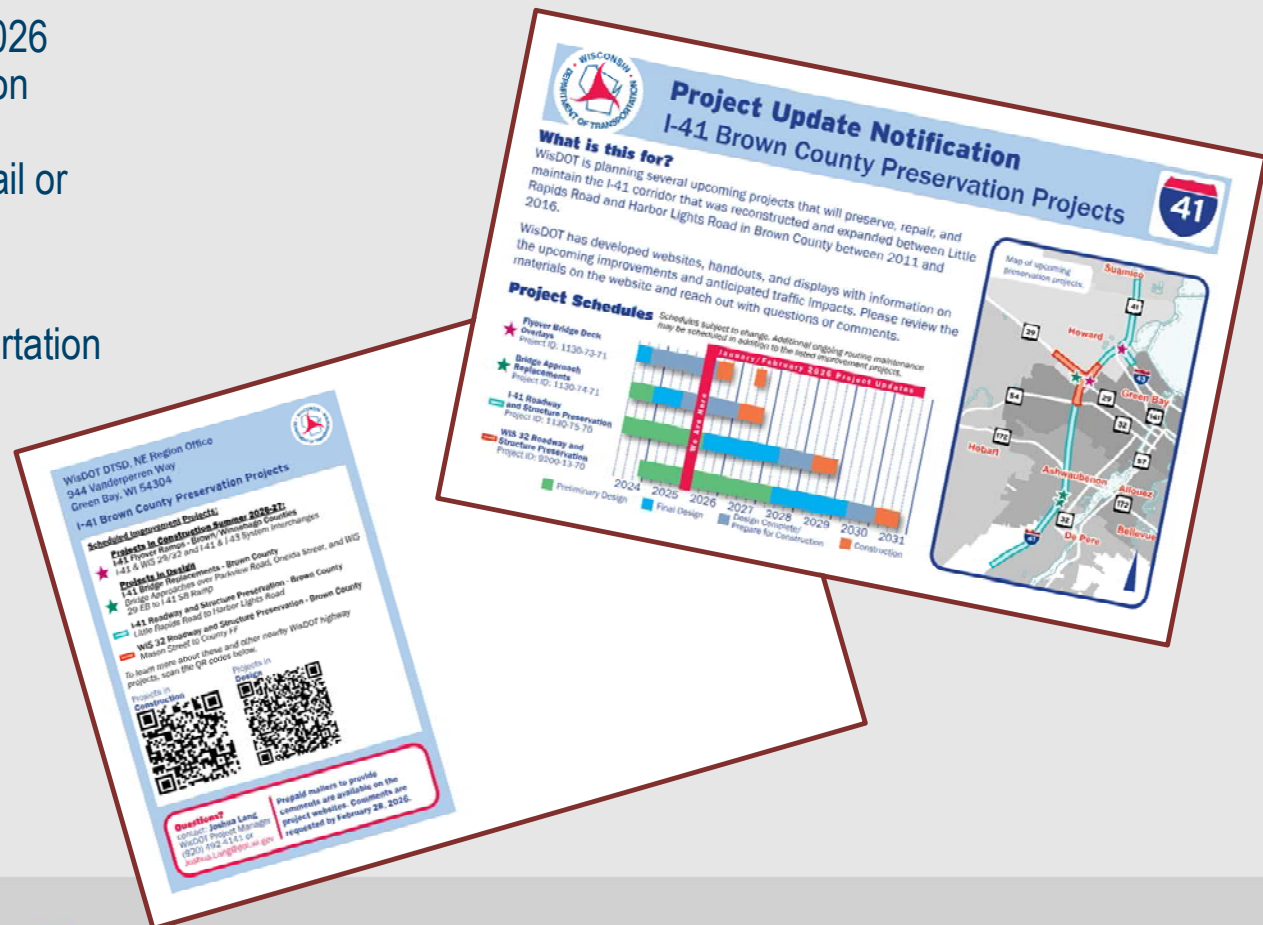

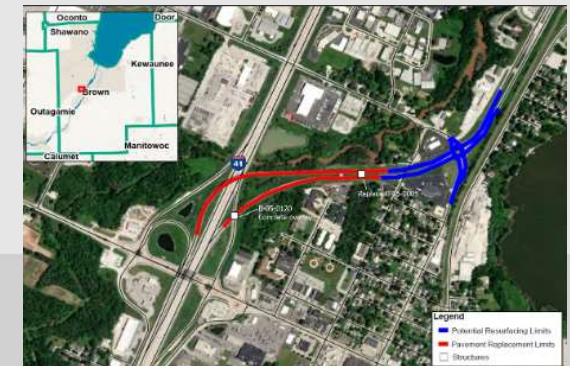

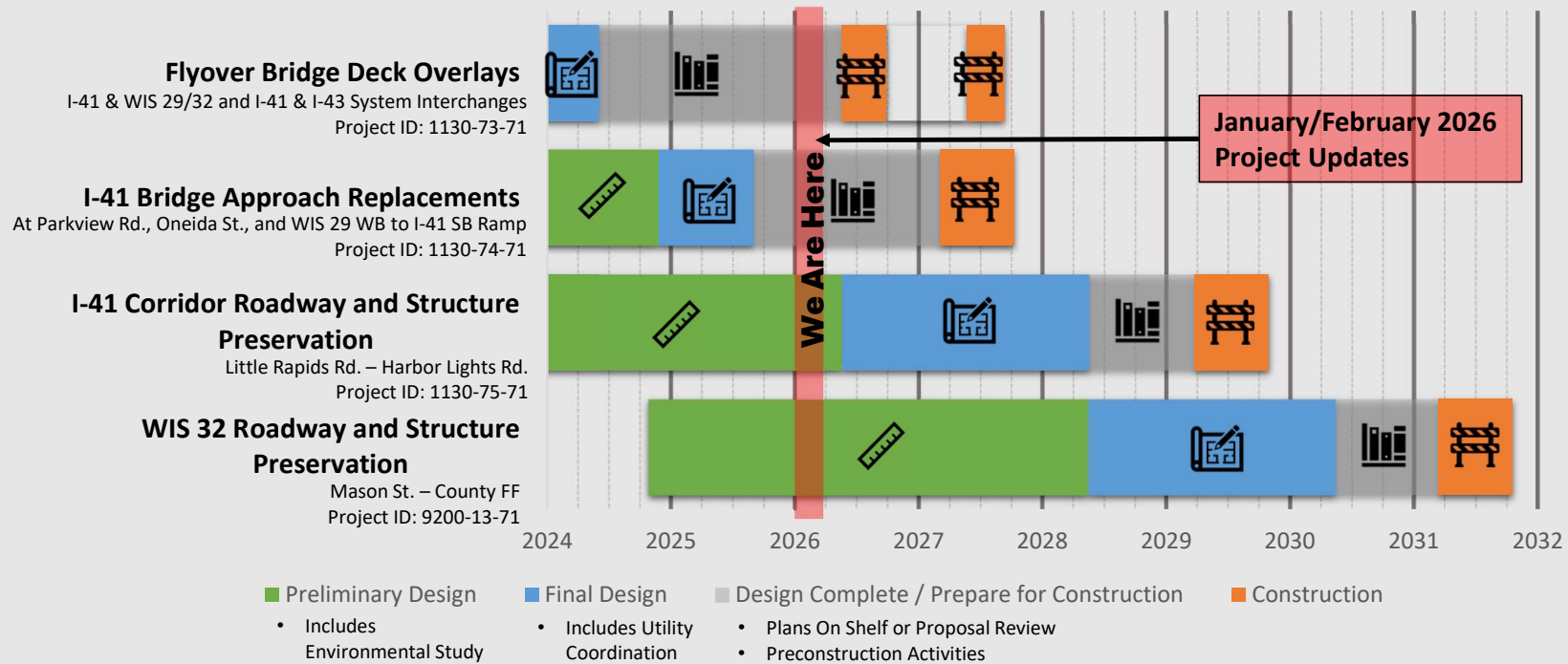
