



WIS 35: Lanquist Street to WIS 70 East Burnett County

June 2, 2026



Project Information

To address deteriorating pavement and other issues, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation project includes:

- Replacing pavement with new concrete from Lanquist Street to Southshore Drive
- Improving storm sewer capacity from Lanquist to Works Progress Street
- Resurfacing the roadway from Southshore Drive to WIS 70 East
- Reconstructing intersection of WIS 35, WIS 70, and County B
- Replacing curb ramps
- Removing asphalt from Park Street to Northshore Drive to reduce flooding potential

Traffic Impacts

During resurfacing from Southshore Drive to the WIS 70 East roundabout:

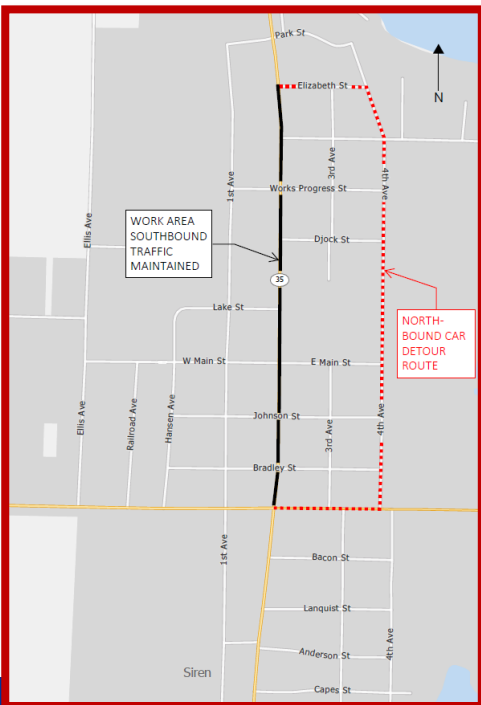
- Motorists will encounter single-lane closures
- Ditch work taking place

During the pavement replacement from Lanquist Street to Southshore Drive:

- Only southbound car traffic will be allowed, and northbound car and all truck traffic will be detoured

Staging

- Stage 2: Week of June 8 – July
 - Replace concrete pavement on one side of WIS 35: Traffic detoured
- Stage 3: July – September
 - Replace concrete pavement on the other side: Traffic detoured
- Stage 4: September
 - Work on gap areas and remove temporary widening: Flagging
- Stage 5: September – October
 - Complete finishing items: Flagging



Detour Information

- Northbound car detour: County B, 4th Avenue North and Elizabeth Street.
- Truck detour: WIS 70/MN 70, I-35 (MN), MN 48/WIS 77 and WIS 35.



Construction

- Start: May 4, 2026
- Completion: October 2026
