Racine Street roundabouts open today in Menasha

Temporary lighting installed

(Menasha) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region announces the new Racine Street roundabout intersections with Ahnaip Street and Main Street open to travel today, Thursday, Sept. 15, 2022. The contractor is expected to open the roundabouts with temporary street lighting after 5 p.m. this evening. Permanent light fixtures will be installed later this year when the contractor is able to obtain them from the manufacturer.

Components that are necessary to raise and lower the bridge, along with the permanent parts required to provide lighting at the roundabout intersections, are delayed due to material supply issues. The Racine Street Bridge is scheduled to open to traffic by mid-December this year. Material supply issues forced the opening date to be pushed back from the original September 2022 date.

This project includes replacing the Racine Street Bridge with a new lift bridge that is located along the east side of the existing bridge. The project also includes the new roundabouts at the Racine Street intersections with Main Street on the north side of the river and Ahnaip Street on the south side of the river.
