Weekly Construction Update


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing construction along US 18/151 between County G and WIS 69 to address emerging traffic growth and operational deficiencies. Auxiliary lanes will be added, along with interchange and safety improvements. Construction began in March and is scheduled to be complete in late 2025.

WORK PROGRESS

- County G/Dairy Ridge Road:
 - o This week: restoration, epoxy pavement markings, sign installation, and traffic signal work
 - o Next week: Traffic signal activation, guardrail, finish pavement markings, and OPEN ROADWAY AND RAMPS TO TRAFFIC!
- US 18/151 Auxiliary lanes:
 - o This week: pavement markings, removal of concrete barrier block
 - o Next week: rumble strip installation, median quardrail, cable quard, and OPEN ALL LANES TO TRAFFIC!
- W. Verona Avenue/Epic Lane entrance ramp to eastbound US 18/151:
 - o This week: final pavement removals, grading, and concrete pavement approach slab
 - o Next week: asphalt shoulder paving, gravel shouldering, beam guard installation, pavement markings, removal of concrete barrier block, and OPEN BOTH RAMP LANES TO TRAFFIC!

TRAFFIC ACCESS IMPACTS

- EVERYTHING IS SET TO OPEN UP TO TRAFFIC BY END OF NEXT WEEK!
- The speed limit on US 18/151, between Spring Rose Road and WIS 69, is reduced to 55 mph when work is taking place
- US 18/151, between County G and W. Verona Ave./Epic Lane, reduced to one lane in each direction
- County G/ Dairy Ridge Road over US 18/151 and the eastbound and westbound US 18/151 ramps at County G are closed
- Overnight closure of the W. Verona Avenue/Epic Lane entrance ramp to eastbound US 18/151 Monday, November 17, and Tuesday, November 18 from 8 p.m. - 6 a.m.


