

Project Update

Work to Resume Along US 18/151

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be resuming construction next week along US 18/151 between County G and WIS 69 with scheduled completion in June 2026.

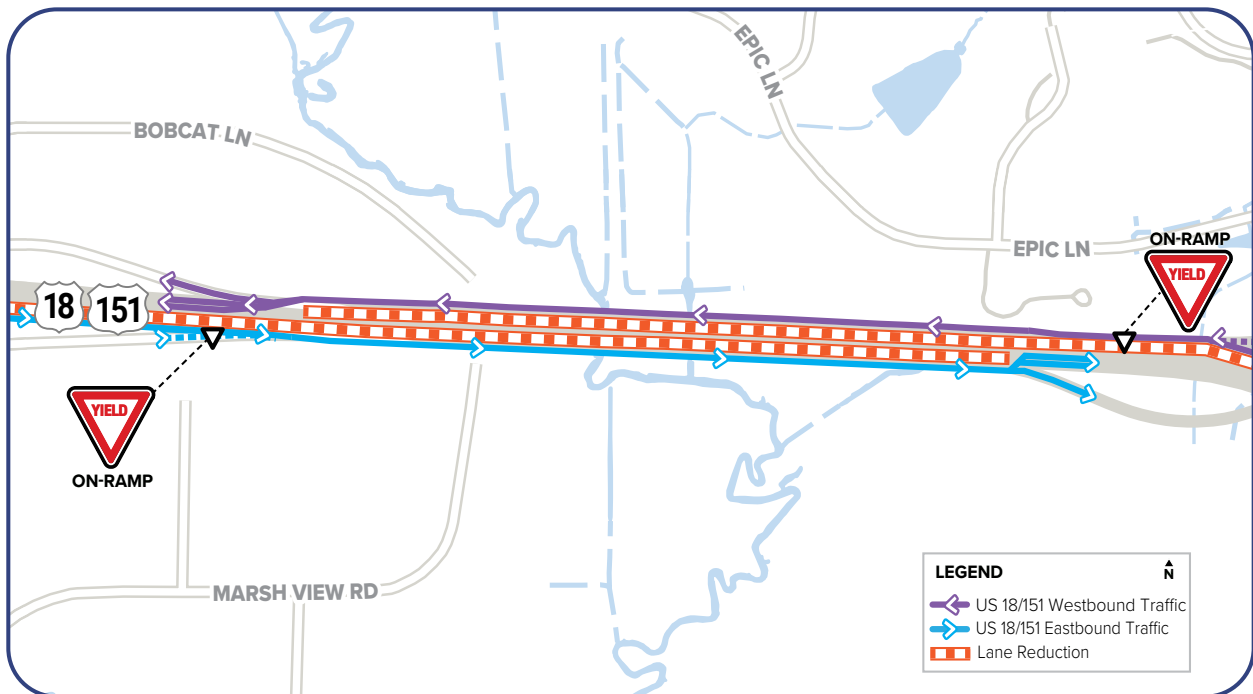
Work to be completed this spring and summer:

- Remaining work at Sugar River bridges including median wing wall reconstruction, deck rehabilitation, approach slab pavement reconstruction, and bridge deck polymer overlay
- Apply new pavement marking lines on US 18/151 and ramps from County G to WIS 69
- Final restoration work and punch list items throughout project limits

Traffic Access Impacts:

- Beginning **Monday, March 23**, traffic on US 18/151 is scheduled to be reduced to one lane in each direction between County G and W. Verona Avenue. A single outside lane of traffic will be utilizing the outside lane with temporary concrete barrier wall in place at the Sugar River bridges for crews to complete work on the median sides of both bridges
- Eastbound On-Ramp traffic from County G and Westbound On-Ramp traffic from W. Verona Ave. will be required to YIELD prior to merging in to the single lane of US 18/151 mainline traffic

The speed limit on US 18/151, between Spring Rose Road and WIS 69, will be reduced to 55 mph during this project.
