Construction Update Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has contracted with Northeast Asphalt to rehabilitate WIS 67 from WIS 60 to W Jct. County S. Work includes culvert replacements, milling, mainline HMA paving, curb & gutter, permanent pavement markings and restoration.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS & DETOUR

WIS 67 is closed to thru traffic throughout the duration of construction. Local access to residents and businesses within the work zone will be maintained during construction. On June 7th, the railroad crossing with WIS 67 just north of eastbound County S is scheduled to be replaced. The duration of this work is scheduled for 4 days (weather pending). During this time, WIS 67 will be closed to **all** traffic at the railroad crossing.

Local traffic and business truck traffic should utilize WIS 67 from south of the railroad crossing to access Iron Ridge and locations south of the railroad crossing. Bussing, garbage pickup and mail will be maintained during this work, but modified routes may be needed.

The detour for this project will utilize WIS 60 to WIS 26 to WIS 33 (see detour map on back).

PROPOSED SCHEDULE

Railroad crossing replacement work is scheduled to start on June 7th and be completed on June 10th (weather pending).

WIS 67 milling and paving operations will be occurring throughout the project limits (WIS 60 to westbound County S) until late June. These work operations will be controlling local traffic with flagging.
