Glenview Avenue/84th Street

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) reconstructed Glenview Avenue from just north of Wisconsin Avenue to just south of Bluemound Road, and resurfaced 84th Street from Bluemound Road to Adler Street. WisDOT reconstructed Glenview Avenue to improve local traffic flow both during and after Zoo Interchange freeway construction.

BACKGROUND

Prior to roadway construction extensive utility work was done by the local municipalities and utilities to avoid “tearing up the road twice”.


The improvements to Glenview Avenue include a two-way left turn lane and modifications to the signals at Wisconsin Avenue and Bluemound Road.

Intersection improvements at Wisconsin Avenue and Bluemound Road make the area safer for pedestrians. Improvements include enhanced crosswalk areas and pedestrian countdown timers, left turn lanes and arrows. Pedestrian safety is particularly sensitive in this area with three schools on the route.

The intersection improvements include emergency vehicle pre-emption (the operation of signals) for safer, more efficient operations of emergency vehicles traveling the corridor.

WHAT'S NEXT?

In 2014-16 there will be periodic closures of the 84th Street and I-94 interchange ramps for reconstruction. 84th Street from Adler Street to Honey Creek Parkway will be reconstructed at this time.
