Wisconsin Avenue - *temporary exit*

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) constructed a temporary exit at Wisconsin Avenue from northbound US 45.

The new exit is helping to alleviate congestion during reconstruction of WIS 100 and provides reliable access to the area during the Watertown Plank Road and other reconstruction projects.

BACKGROUND

The temporary exit provides an additional exit adjacent to the Bluemound Road loop which extends to Wisconsin Avenue.

To accommodate the temporary exit to Wisconsin Avenue, WisDOT constructed a temporary cul-de-sac on 95th Street at Wisconsin Avenue.


97th Street remains open as a connection between Wisconsin Avenue and Bluemound Road.

With a project of this magnitude, temporary ramps are built to accommodate traffic during construction.

WHAT'S NEXT?

In late 2014 - mid 2015, the temporary exit to Wisconsin Avenue will be removed, a new interchange will be built at Bluemound Road. The Wisconsin Avenue bridge over US 45 will be rebuilt in 2015-16.

Parking will be removed and temporary improvements will be made to Wisconsin Avenue east of US 45 to improve access to and from the medical center.
